The High Commission of the United Republic of Tanzania in Nairobi avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Embassy of Hungary the assurances of its highest consideration.

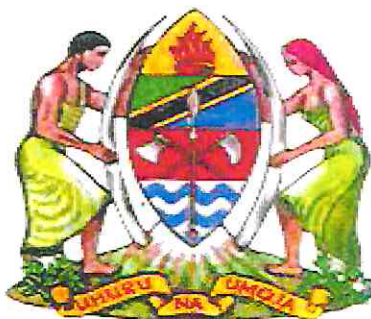

**Tanzania Scholarship for Bachelor's and master's degree
programmes for Hungary students in Tanzania 2024/2025**

1.1. Mission of the Programme

The Government of Tanzania provides Scholarship Programme for Hungary students to study in Tanzania Institutions. The programme's core mission is to strengthen existing cooperation between two parties and increase the number of international students in Tanzania and encourage Tanzania higher education institutions to attract international students. The Scholarship Programme is managed by Ministry of Education, Science and Technology of Tanzania through Ministry of Foreign Affairs and East Africa Cooperation of Tanzania.

The programme is based on bilateral educational cooperation agreements signed between the Ministries responsible for education in Hungary and Ministry of Education, science and Technology of Tanzania. The scholarship program offers both full degree (bachelor's and master's programmes) in the English language.

Hungarian scholarship holders are encouraged to focus on their academic advancement during their stay in Tanzania as all their tuition fees are covered, and their accommodation and living costs are supported as well. The programme's success is a testament to the quality and competitiveness. The programme allows students to showcase Tanzania cultural heritage and promote cultural exchange between nations.

- 1.3.1. Free tuition fees - exemption from the payment of tuition fee;
- 1.3.2. Training Materials;
- 1.3.3. Monthly stipend - bachelor's and master's until the completion of studies;
- 1.3.4. Upkeep allowance;
- 1.3.5. Accommodation contribution - free dormitory place;
- 1.3.6. Health insurance services according to the relevant Tanzania legislation
(National health insurance card).

Medical Certificate	Mandatory only for the applicants nominated - scanned copy of a medical certificate of satisfactory health condition - certificates must be issued and signed by a physician to declare the medical condition of the applicant - the certificate must be recently issued.
